



## Open Burning Permit

### Section 51.5 of the City Code

**Large Brush Piles.** An owner or occupant of property may burn large brush piles on his own property between November 15 and March 15 provided the burn pile is a minimum of 300 feet from the nearest occupied dwelling. The person desiring to burn a brush pile shall apply for a permit from the City, pay a permit fee of \$25.00, and burn the brush within two weeks of the issuance of the permit. The permittee will adequately monitor the burning brush pile at all times.

**Ditches.** The open burning of ditches that are unable to be mowed will be allowed between November 15 and March 15. The person desiring to burn a ditch must apply for a permit from the City, pay a permit fee of \$25.00, and complete the burning within two weeks of the issuance of the permit. The permittee must be present during the burning.
